Scope of Work

The Site Ion Exchange Effluent Plant (SIXEP) was required by BNFL to help reduce the levels of radioactivity in effluent discharges from Sellafield into the Irish Sea.

This was achieved primarily by using ion exchange technology.

Other equipment included sand filters, pH correction and various monitoring and storage tanks.
